	5.2.	On 02 October 2020, the Authority published the Invitation to Apply on the licensing process for International Mobile Telecommunications ("IMT") in respect of the provision of the mobile broadband wireless access services for urban and rural areas using complimentary bands IMT700, IMT800, IMT2600 and IMT3500 published in the Government Gazette 43768 ("ITA").	
	5.3.	On 22 December 2020, Telkom instituted litigation proceedings against ICASA and 12 others. On 09 March 2021, MTN filed the court application against the Authority's ITA. Subsequently, on 23 March 2021, Vodacom submitted its counter application to have the Court confirm the correct interpretation of the Opt-In Scheme.	
	5.4.	Pursuant to settlement negotiations amongst the litigants in the Telkom Application, on 15 September 2021, the Court granted an order, amongst other things, reviewing and setting aside the ITA and referring the matter back to ICASA for consideration. This led to the withdrawal of the application filed by MTN.	
	5.5.	On 01 October 2021, in light of the court order the Authority published the second IM consulting the public on the competition assessment, and the ITA.	
	5.6.	The Authority received 10 written submissions within the set deadline of receiving the representations, and 08 written

	The following comments were made:	
	5.12. Council requested clarity over Paragraphs 6.2 and 6.3 as Council was of the view that there was a contradiction between the two paragraphs. Council further expressed that the section should be clear about what would constitute eligibility.	
	5.13. Council further raised concern over paragraph 10.2.1, with regards to underserved areas. Council was of the view that the data being used is outdated, and Council requested that the Authority address the outdated data.	
	5.14. Council requested clarity on whether the Committee has ensured that most of the critical issues raised during the litigation process have been addressed to avoid further litigation.	
	5.15. The Committee informed Council that there will be a mini auction where the contiguous blocks are selected, the auction will be governed by the auction rules.	
	5.16. The Committee informed Council the Regulations on the under -serviced areas should be amended. The Committee expressed to Council that it agrees that the data being used is outdated.	
	5.17. The Committee further informed Council that paragraph 6.2 will be rephrased to avoid confusion.	



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	5.18. The Committee informed Council that the Authority has a discretion to assign obligation in terms of spectrum to the Operators. The Committee further informed Council that the obligations can be amended once the Regulations have been updated.	
	5.19. Council cautioned that the preliminary position that the Authority will take, should minimise drastic turns in the future as this is what lead to the previous interdict applications against the Authority.	
	5.20. Council resolved that the second IM be Gazetted on the 16 th of November 2021. Council further resolved that one (1) day should be included to extend the closing date for submissions, and further amend the timetable to include one (1) day.
