Action Item Person Responsible The purpose of this submission was to request Council to reject the application by Smile Communications (Pty) Ltd ("the Applicant") for a Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence in the 450-470 MHz band. The following was noted: On 19 April 2017, the Applicant submitted an application for a Radio Frequency Spectrum Licence in the 450-470 MHz band for the purpose of providing broadband internet services to its client. The application is bought in terms section 31(2) of the Electronic Communications Act no 36 Of 2005("the ECA Act). The Applicant holds an Individual Electronic Communication Service (I-ECS) and Individual Electronic Communications Network Service (I-ECNS) licence. It does not presently hold any radio frequency spectrum licences. The 450-470 MHz band is currently used by users in the Land Mobile Radio Service. On the 30th March 2015, the Radio Frequency Spectrum Assignment Plan (RFSAP) for the 450-470 MHz band was published. In terms of Clause 6.1 of the RFSAP, the RFSAP comes into effect on 1 April 2018. Additionally, the 450-470 MHz is earmarked for International Mobile Telecommunication (IMT) services. Recommendations

- ▶ It is recommended that Council reject the Applicant's application for a radio frequency spectrum licence in the 450-470 MHz band.
- ➤ It was further recommended that Council approve the amendment of the Radio Frequency Assignment Plan for the 450-470 MHz band to change the date of amendment of current licences in the rural areas from 1 April 2018 to 1 April 2022 to fall in line with all other users within the band.

Recommended Reasons for Rejection

- The radio frequency spectrum is not yet available for assignment.
- No assignments can be made in this band until 1 April 2018 as per the Radio Frequency Assignment Plan of 2015 and
- This Spectrum is earmarked for IMT services and as such can only be licensed through an Invitation to Apply (ITA). An ITA
